

To become a fully accredited (L3) Sweep in Canberra you need to commence the L0-L3 Sweep accreditation process by:

- Undertaking introductory Sweep familiarisation training with your club; minimum three (3) and a maximum of ten (10) hours
- Training hours to be recorded in a Sweep Log Book (supplied hard copy to be used).

Level 1 Trainee Sweep accreditation requirement:

- Register with the DBACT Sweeps Coordinator at sweeps@dbact.com.au
- Successfully complete the AUSDBF online learning module and Sweep assessment questionnaire (100% pass rate): https://ausdbfmoodle.com/moodle30/enrol/index.php?id=16
- Successfully complete on-water training with an AuSDBF Sweep School.

<u>Level 2 Provisional Sweep</u> accreditation requirement:

In addition to the L1 Sweep accreditation requirement

- Maintain a DBACT Sweep logbook, signed by your club (supplied hard copy to be used),
- Log a minimum of twenty (20) <u>additional</u> hours of formal club Sweep training in all types of weather conditions and boat configurations
- Within two (2) years successfully complete an AUSDBF accredited on-water L2 Sweep assessment
- · Hold and maintain accreditations in:
 - First Aid HLTAID011,
 - Working With Vulnerable People (WWVP),
 - Play By The Rules (PBTR) Harassment and Discrimination, and
 - Play By The Rules (PBTR) Child Protection and Safeguarding

Level 3 Accredited Sweep accreditation requirement:

In addition to the L2 Sweep accreditation requirement

- Successfully Sweep, without incident:
 - Two (2) x 200m races, (minimum of one (1) race with a 20s crew)
 - Two (2) x 500m races, (minimum of one (1) race with a 20s crew)
 - One (1) x 2Km race (20s crew)

over at least two (2) regattas.

20s crew: minimum of 18 paddlers

To maintain a Sweep accreditation in Canberra you need to:

- Provide a signed declaration from your Club President/Coach confirming 20 hours p.a. of Sweep activity over the past 3 years, without incident, at regattas and/or club training.
- Maintain a current accreditation in:
 - First Aid HLTAID011,
 - Working With Vulnerable People (WWVP),
 - Play By The Rules (PBTR) Harassment and Discrimination, and
 - Play By The Rules (PBTR) Child Protection and Safeguarding.

Without a signed declaration confirming 20 hours p.a. of Sweep activity and maintenance of accreditations in First Aid, WWVP and PBTRs, Sweeps are required to undertake an onwater re-assessment before re-accreditation.

Sweeps are not to Sweep a boat without in-date Sweep accreditations.
